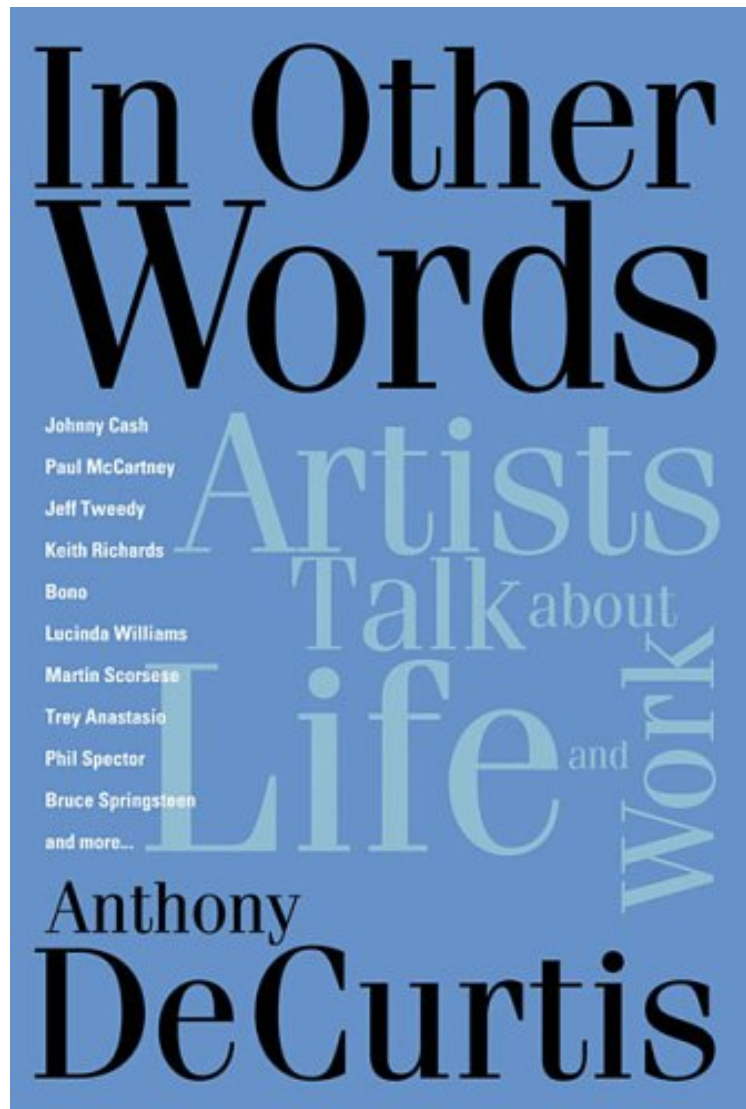

I hadn't heard about Anthony DeCurtis before buying this book, but I knew Rolling Stone magazine had a good track record of hiring outstanding music writers. (Dave Marsh, Ben Fong-Torres, etc.) This collects in-depth conversations with some of the most important artists in Western culture. The questions are very insightful, not intrusive or foolish like many interviews with well-known people. The reader is left with the feeling that he/she has just enjoyed an amazingly interesting private conversation with each of the artists at their home, or sitting on a bench in a park. The Keith Richards interview is by far the most realistic portrayal to date. Richards' devotion to his family and his craft are given proper attention, as well as his sense of indebtedness to the musicians who inspired him.
