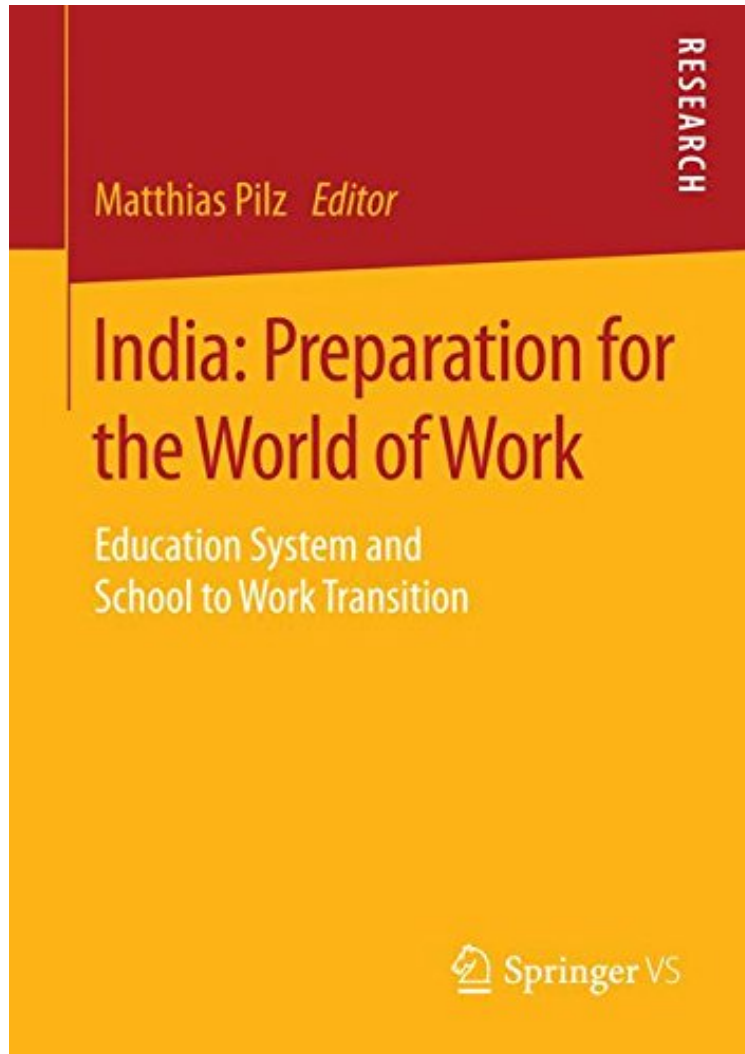


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This book explores how the Indian education and training system prepares young people for the world of work and for the requirements of the employment market because India is a leading industrialised nation with a very young
