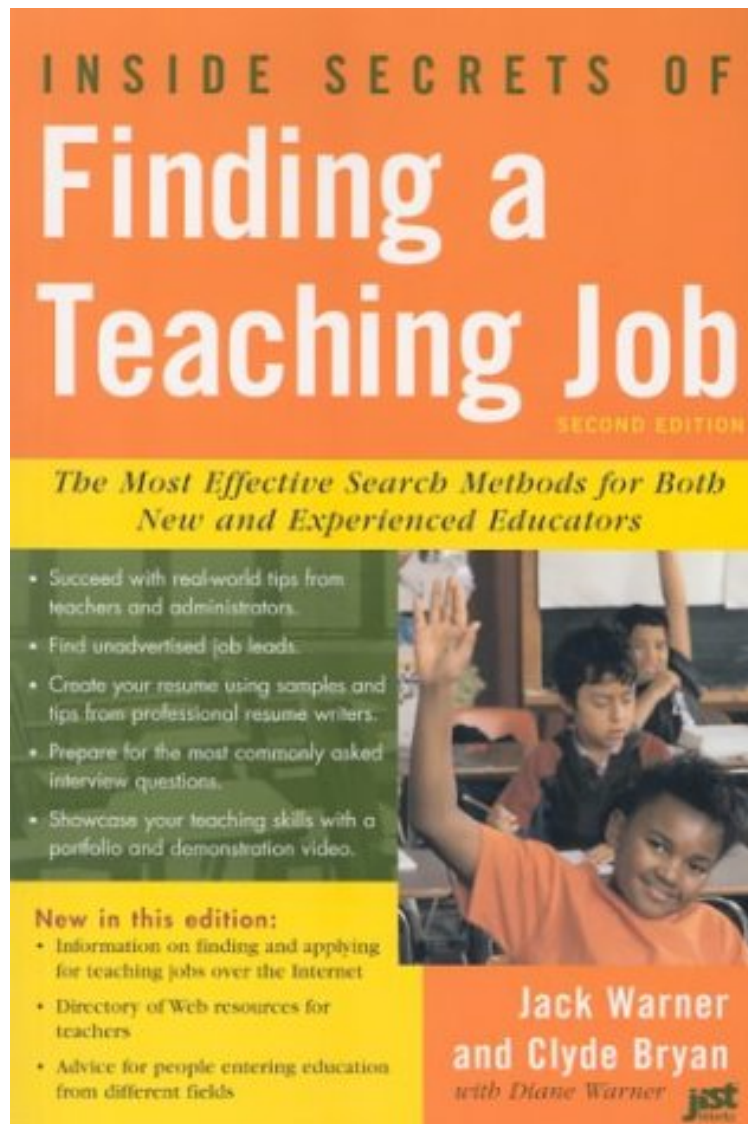

This book helped me land my dream job. The most helpful sections were those on how to write a strong cover letter and resume. I had sent out my letter and resume to over 40 districts and never got a call. After reading this book, I rewrote my letter and resume and immediately received 5 interview calls on the same day. The interview tips in this book were fantastic--I was asked almost every question--and I was offered several positions. There are other teacher interview books that have more detailed interview questions for each content area, but this book definitely included the main questions that interviewers ask in general, as well as suggested responses.
