Excellent BookBy CalcThis is an excellent book, if you're not at all familiar with the NEC or just barely familiar with it or maybe you just want to improve your knowledge of the NEC. The NEC, in my experience, can be very, very difficult to make sense out of, because much of the Code for what you need to do to like, say, sizing feeder or branch conductor and the overcurrent protective devices can be spread around in many different articles and sections/subsections of articles...and much of it depends on what you know about the installation and the particulars about the installation itself. This book shows you exactly what article applies to what you want to do to meet minimum Code requirements. In addition, it gives a great introduction of fundamental electrical principles that you need to know to use the NEC. After reading this book, I learned that one of my colleagues, who supposedly "knew" the NEC well and had studied the basic Mike Holt NEC training book, was absolutely dead wrong about a particular aspect for sizing conductor, and it only took me about an hour or two of reading this book and referring to the NEC to figure that out. Then again, I'm not very familiar with the NEC, but, still, it took me a relatively short amount of time to figure out that guy was wrong, with the aid of this book! Keep in mind, my colleague had studied the Mike Holt NEC basic training book that costs over \$100! Maybe the guy just didn't study hard enough or didn't comprehend what Holt's book was saying, which is even worse...either way, not good for an over \$100 investment! This book cost me less than \$80, new, and, again, it very quickly showed me my colleague's

error by stepping through what Code and information about the installation was necessary to know for completing a task; it shows one what to do if this or that piece of information unknown...the Code actually compensates for some of those situations!
