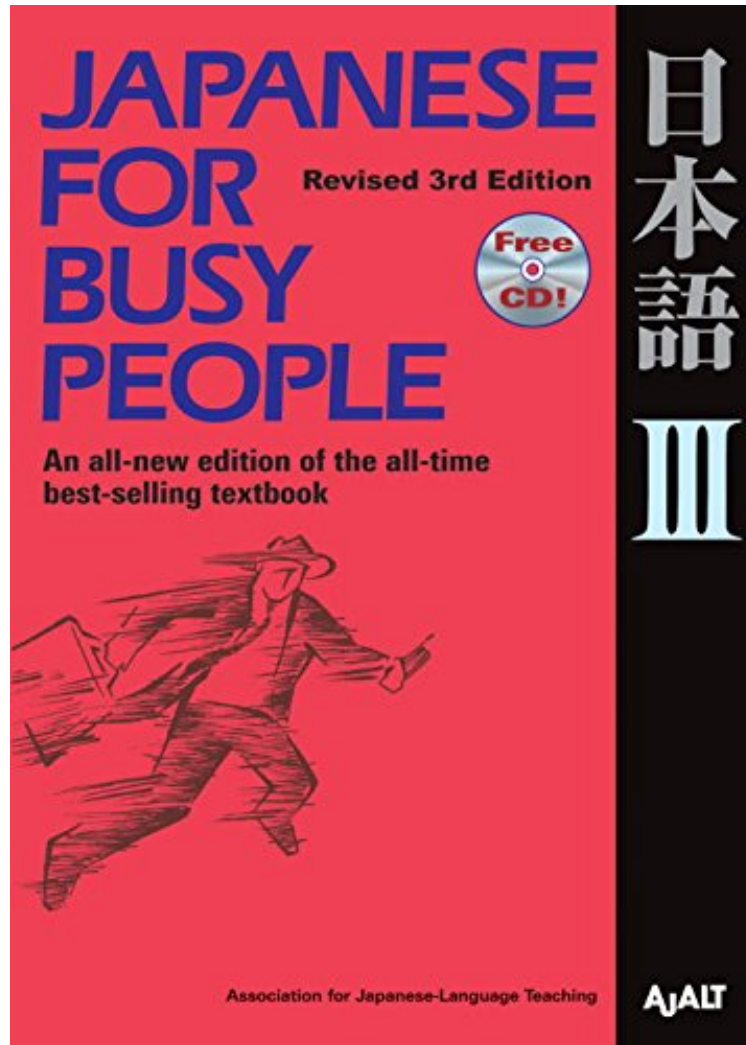

Unfortunately, the explanations of grammar in volume III seem much harder to follow. There's a lot of interesting material here, but I wish the authors had given more help in understanding the material that they present. After starting this volume, I almost gave up and then decided to push ahead, concentrating on the bits that I do understand, even if it means skipping quite a bit.
