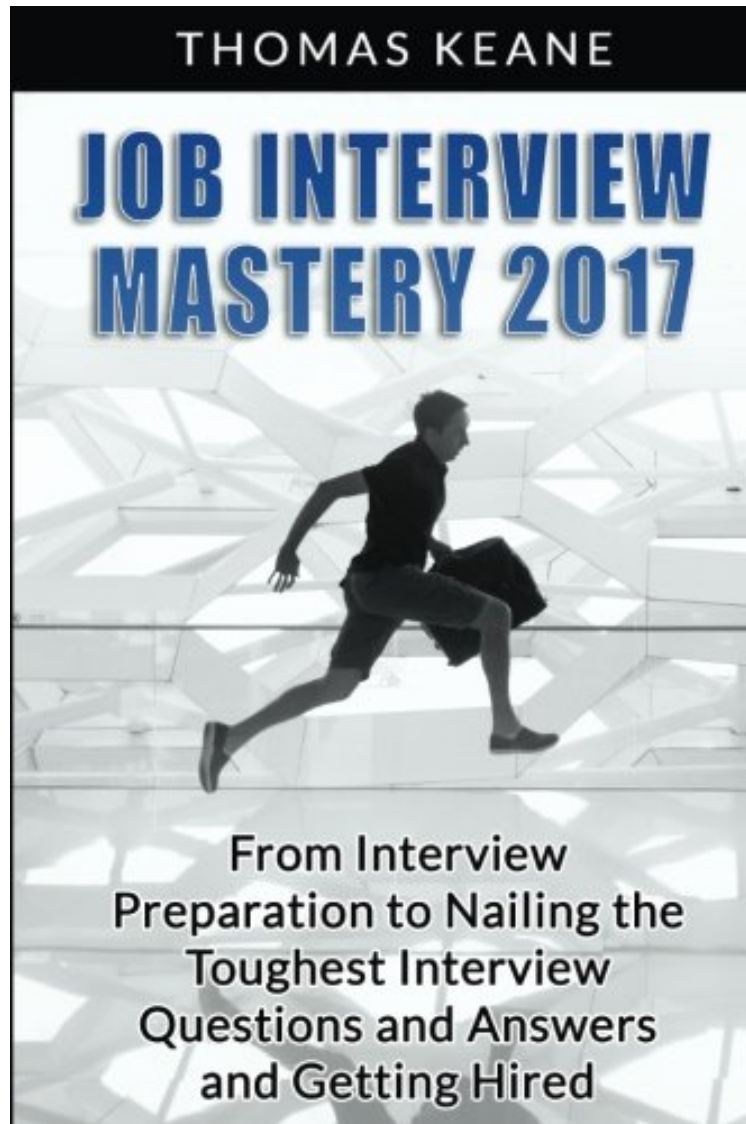

Barnack This book contains sound advice on preparing for a job interview and performing well during the interview. Books on this general topic are common in commonly mediocre. This one is an exception, with much specific guidance, how-tos, and step-by-step instructions you can actually follow. The chapters cover interview preparation (e.g., self-assessment, CV or resume, understanding and internalizing the jobs requirements, knowing about the employer), interview dress code (explained and described for men and women), knowing what interviewers want (company specific stuff and general, such as professionalism, communication skills, problem-solving), body language (several examples to model), and how to sell yourself using key communication skills (e.g., friendliness, clarity, brevity). The last chapter contains 50 questions that commonly pop up during job interviews (e.g., Tell me something about yourself, Why should I hire you? Why are you interested in the position offered?). The last chapter is worth the price of the book alone, as its like a cheat sheet for a test, and what is a job interview if not a test?
