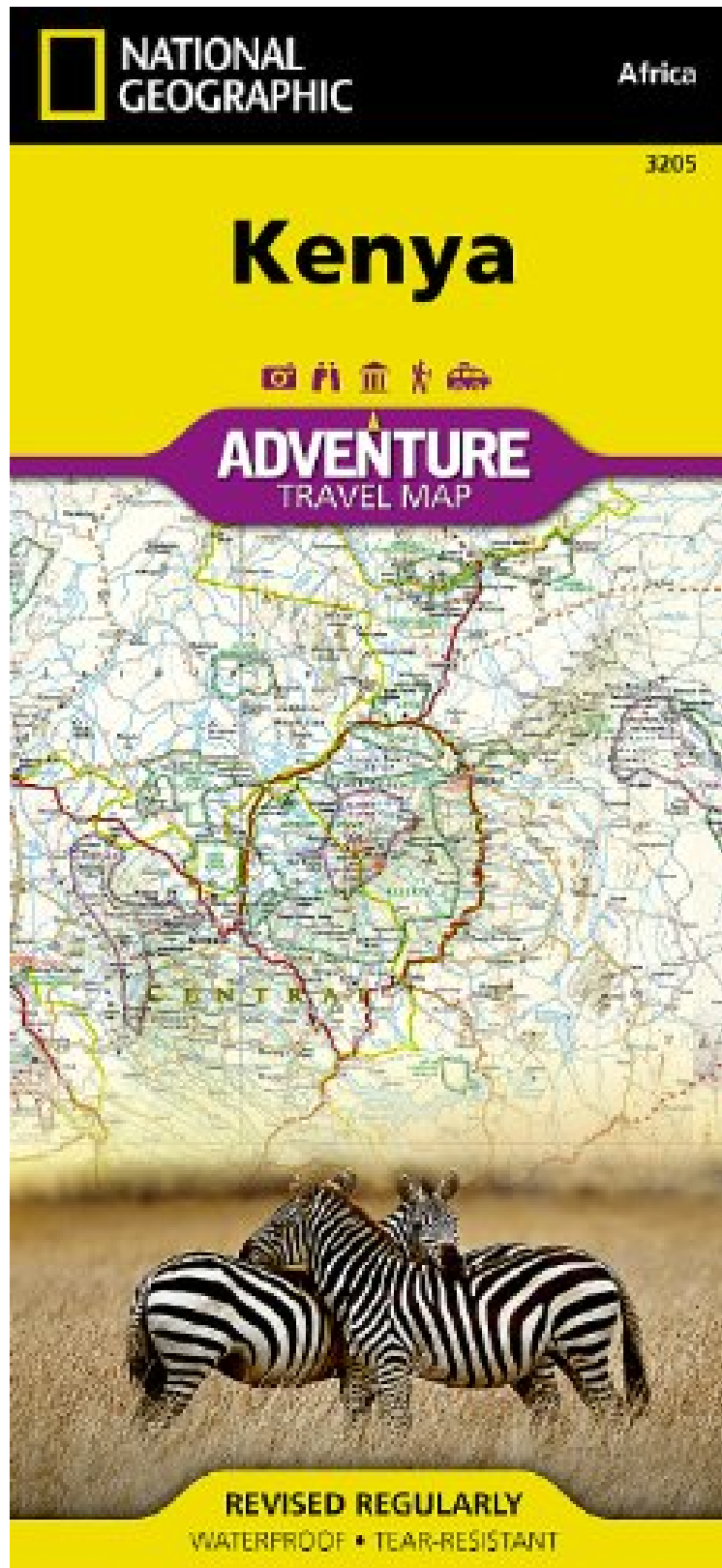

Roads among the major cities are shown along with ways that these connect to the main destinations for foreign travelers, and there are helpful symbols for different sorts of features at the various sites. What I need, however, is a country map that includes city maps of Mombasa, Nairobi, and Kisumu. I was hoping that this map would include insets; I wanted NG authority and detail at a local as well as country-wide level. Alas, nothing. I need paper maps--wandering around Mombasa holding an iPad ahead of me is not preferred--and these don't seem to be available outside of stores in those cities. Oh well.
