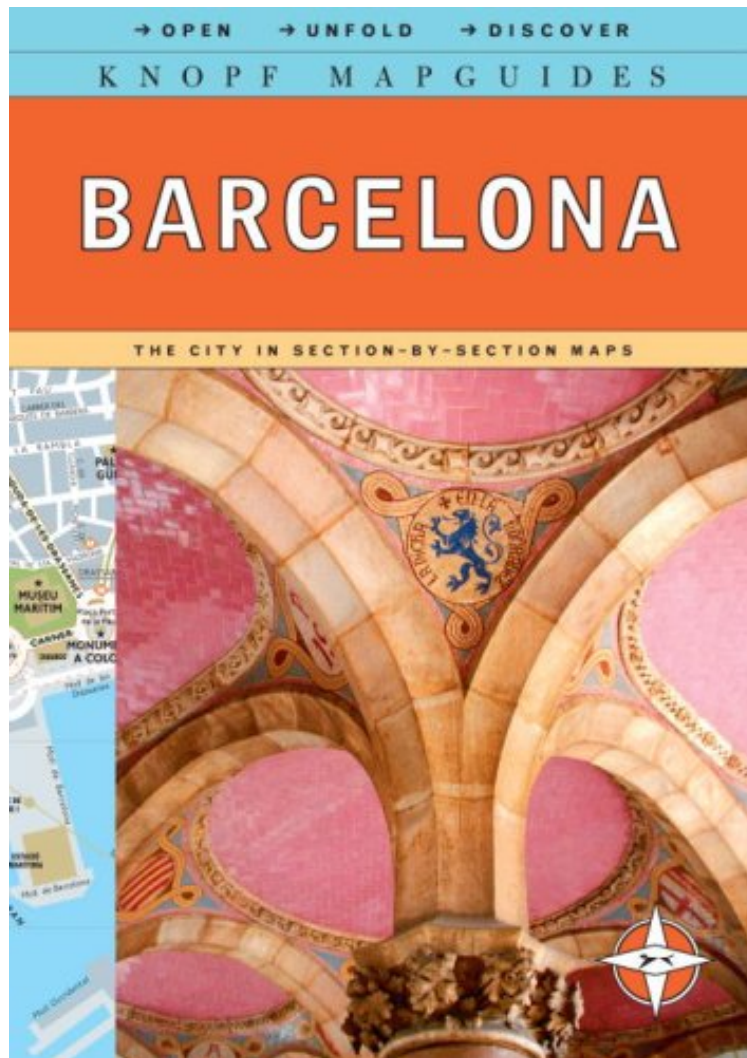

The saddle stitching is durable and the book easily

fits in a jacket pocket. The maps for each section of the city are easy to flip open and the color makes them easy to read. The highlighting of Metro stations on all maps in addition to the having the entire Metro map inside the back cover is a great feature. The highlights and recommendations for each area are basic, but good enough if you're only visiting for a few days. It's extremely well designed and organized. Good overview of the city with a guide for each of the different neighborhoods (or groups of neighborhoods, rather). We used this as our only map for a week long trip. It has a nice metro map as well and it's nice to be able to go out for the day and refer to the book to find out what good food or shops might be nearby. I wish they made these for every city. They're fairly inconspicuous as well so you don't feel like a goof standing on the side of the road with a big ole' map.

This opening fold-out contains a general map of Barcelona to help you visualize the 6 large districts discussed in this guide, and 4 pages of valuable information, handy tips and useful addresses. For each district there is a double-page of addresses (restaurants listed in ascending order of price, cafes, bars, music venues and stores) followed by a fold-out map for the relevant area with the essential places to see (indicated on the map by a star *). These places are by no means all that Barcelona has to offer but to us they are unmissable. The grid-referencing system (A B2) makes it easy for you to pinpoint addresses quickly on the map. Transportation and hotels in Barcelona. The last fold-out consists of a transportation map and 4 pages of practical information that include a selection of hotels. A thematic index lists all the sites and addresses featured in this guide.
