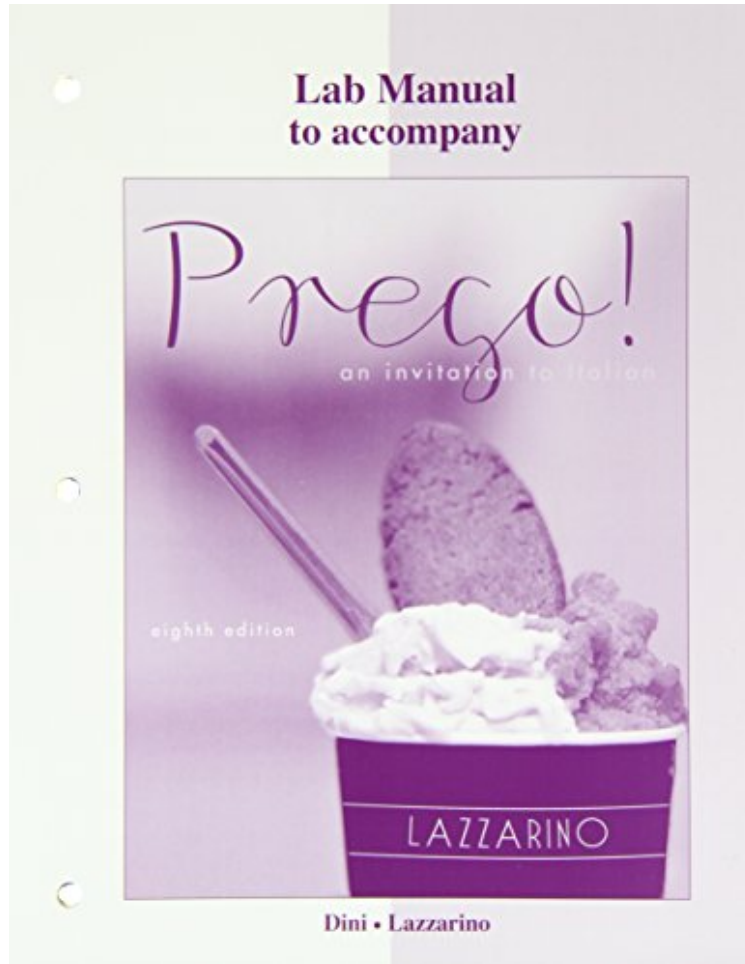

It seems to be a decent enough text but I feel it presumes prior knowledge of Italian which for an "Introduction" to "Beginning Italian" is an oversight.
