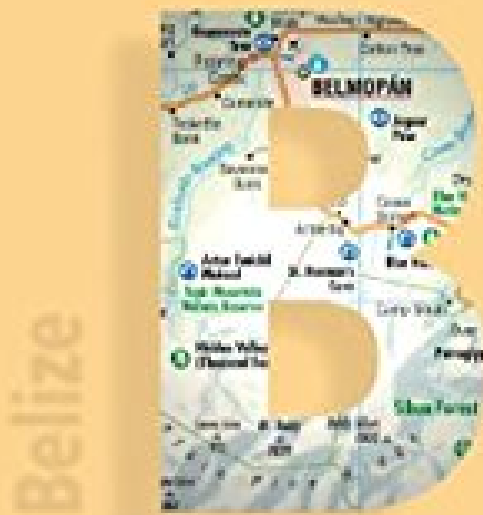

I just got back from a 2-week trip and after putting nearly 800 miles on the odometer, can attest that this map has just enough good information in it so you can get from Point A to B with reasonable reliability. Even with the map, you have to understand that there are few road signs on the highways and even fewer street signs in the city, so a lot of what's on the map needs to be used with guesswork or common sense. The maps of the ruins were useful in helping us determine which Mayan sites would give us the most bang for our buck. The few maps I did see in Belize, including one at the car rental place and one at a gas station, were poor substitutes to the Borch map. Despite a cracked windshield and the \$250 deductible it cost me (James Bus Lines drivers are nutcases,) I actually do recommend you rent a car if you're spending time on the mainland. There's a lot to do and see, despite the small size of the country.
