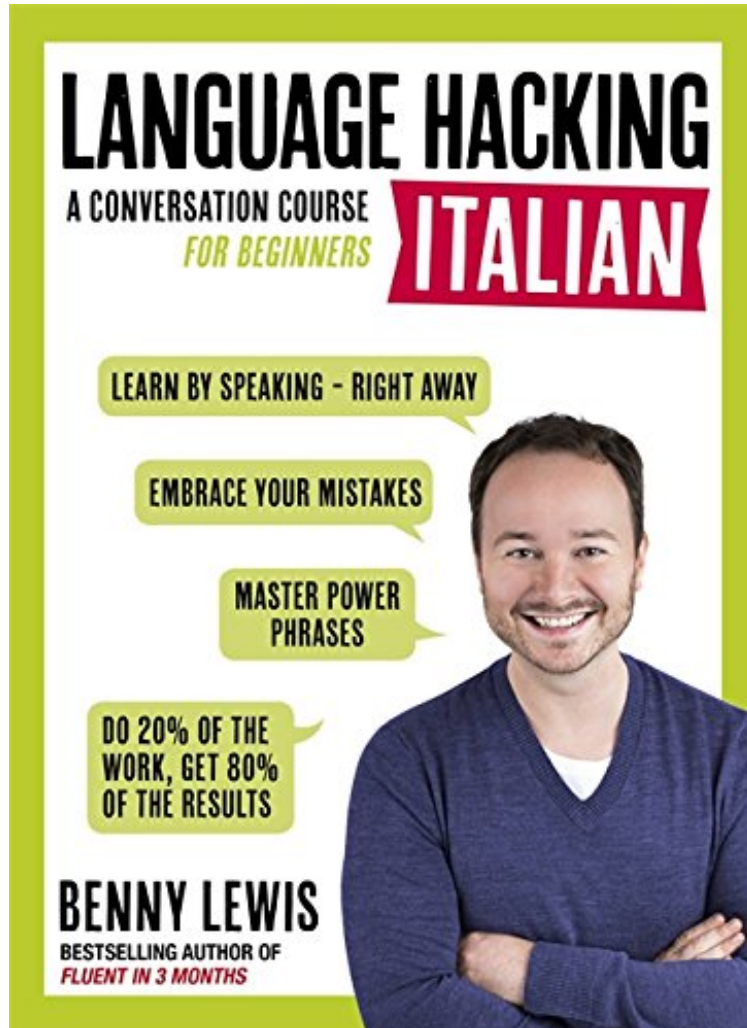

I was surprised at how easy it was to learn. I have used other methods by myself to learn a new language, studying for two years and still not being able to put sentences together. I knew lots of words but could not hold a conversation. This method is different from other methods in that you are encouraged to speak, using phrases and sentence that have meaning to you, that you would actually be able to use in common conversation. I had never spoken or even tried to learn Italian before I joined the early testing group. Within the first week I was able to speak on video for about 30 seconds.
