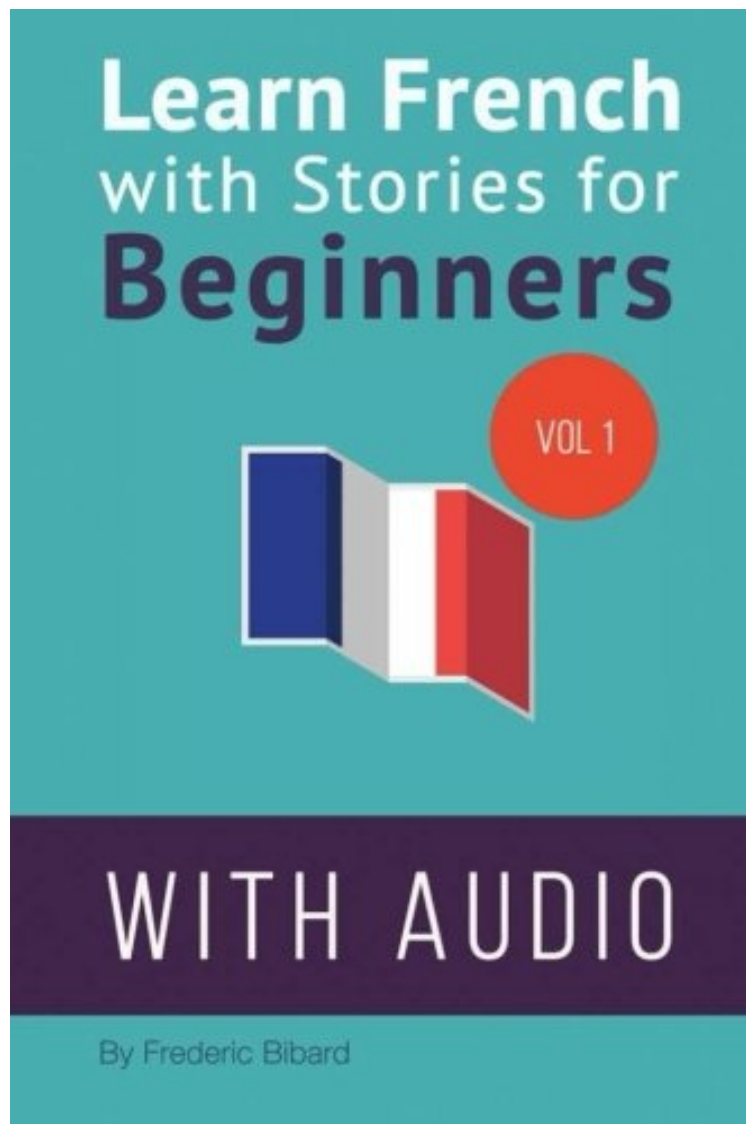

The key vocabulary words are included near the stories for easy referral, so it was easy to follow along and understand the story line without knowing French beforehand. I would also recommend downloading the audio that is available in the book. After reading I downloaded the audio and listened while following along. It has two speeds available- a slower one for beginners and practicing your pronunciation, and a faster one for listening at normal speeds. Now I know how to pronounce many French words and phrases, and I can continue to go back and practice. It also prepared me to be able to understand people speaking French, along with the written French. This book makes it possible to practice the vocabulary, listen to the French language, read and hear conversations, and understand stories written and spoken in French. I liked how the chapters were broken down by subjects (the weather, clothes, family, etc.), which aided in understanding what vocabulary you are learning in the story. As my own preference, I would have liked if the words and phrases were introduced before the story line, but some may like reading the passages in French and then figuring out what the words mean.
