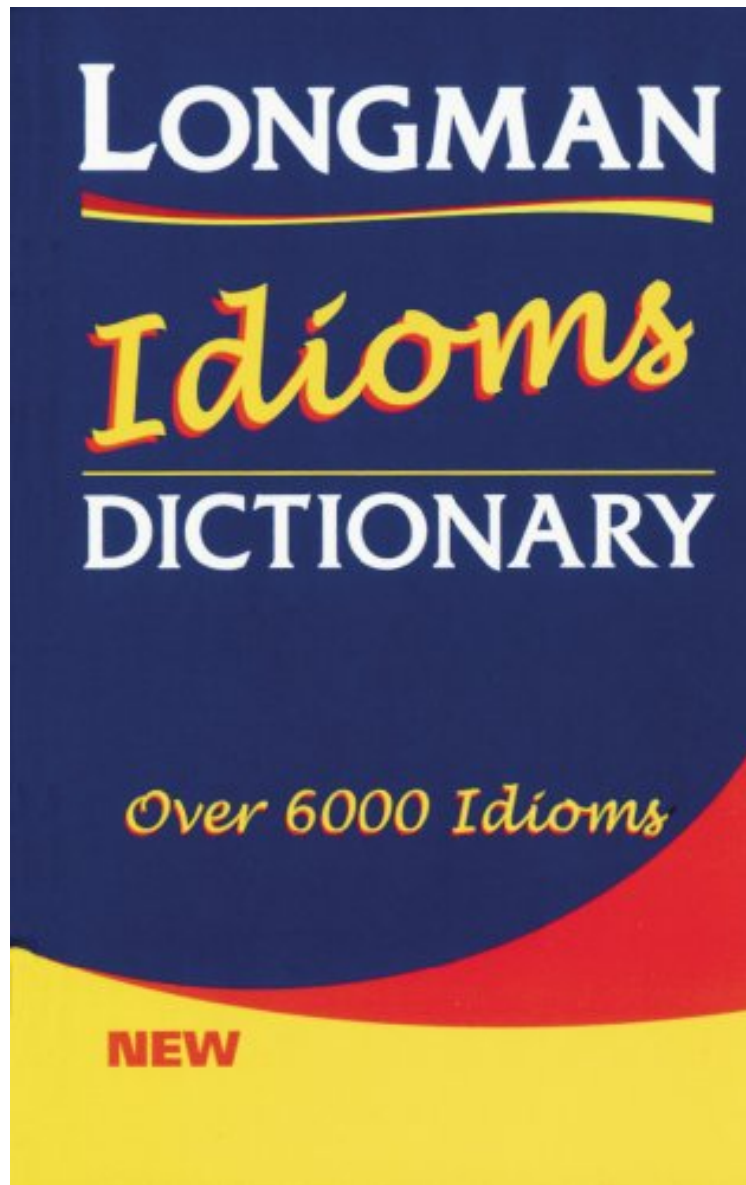

There's a really good section called the "Idiom Activator". It helps you find idioms by concepts. Unfortunately, it only has ten concept areas. It would be really useful if they expanded that section. But overall I would strongly recommend this dictionary for intermediate and advanced learners.
