By Customer The author needs a serious editor. There are some errors that leave you spinning until you realize that the author did the math wrong. For example, explanation of question 24 on page 146, has an errant 6. Not the only mistake. Reducing the fractions could get you  $\frac{6}{20}$  instead of  $\frac{1}{6}$ . Again, the author needs a good editor.
