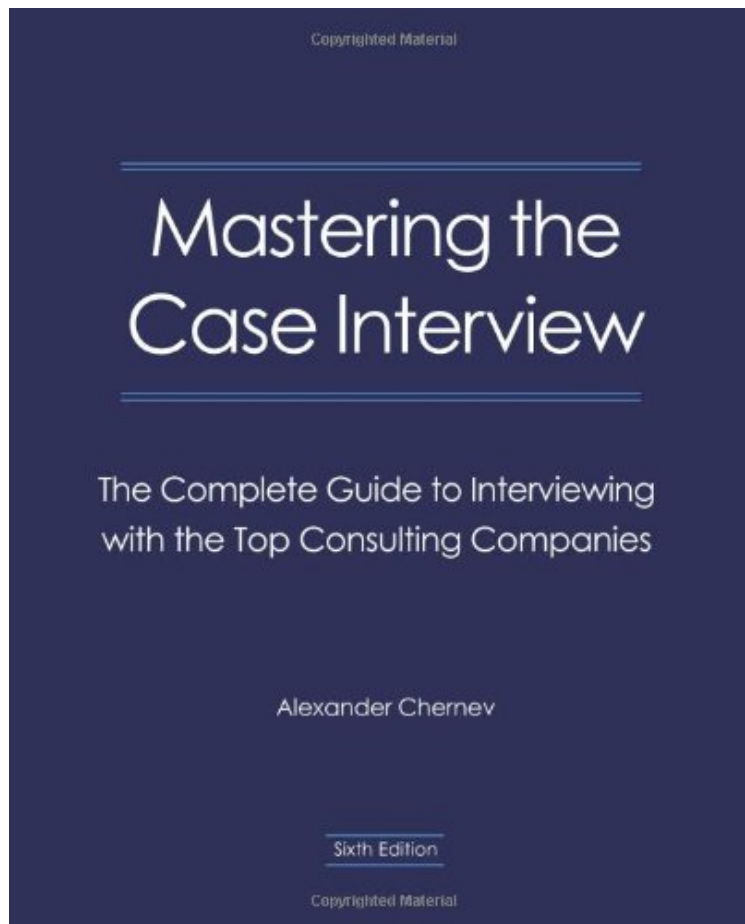

A few pearls, but mostly falls flatBy hydrangeaUnfortunately, this book has a shocking lack of diagrams and numbers in the chapters devoted to case interview prep.I really like the first few chapters on preparing your resume and prepping for the personal experience interview. There is a great framework/matrix for organizing your

experiences. I think the appendices at the end of the book are good as well for reviewing some financial and economics concepts. There are also lots of examples of cases that they give you (just the prompt, no data) that can be helpful for preparing on your own. But I don't put much stock in the 4 "frameworks" they give you for solving cases. In reality, there's no frame; just a lot of written words that you have to sort through to find anything useful. And pearls buried amongst marginally organized fluff won't fly in a real case situation. Use this book for more questions that can help you practice, the appendices, and the chapters on the PEI. But I think for actual frameworks on how to solve cases, you're MUCH better off with a different book. 3 of 3 people found the following review helpful. Good book for a second reference... By Chsus This book is a good resource preparing for case-interviews but not as the first or the only resource. It plays a very good second fiddle in providing a broader (also different) perspective about case frameworks, but using it alone might get you in trouble since it doesn't cover all possible scenarios and it is not thoroughly generic in the frameworks. The material for Personal Experience Interviews is very weak. The strongest point of this book is the fact that it has a number of cases spelled out as a dialogue between the interviewer and interviewee. The cases written out like that are actually more in number than "Case-in-point". So my suggestion, if you can afford to buy two books, get case-in-point and then this one. If only one, then get case-in-point. Good luck.
