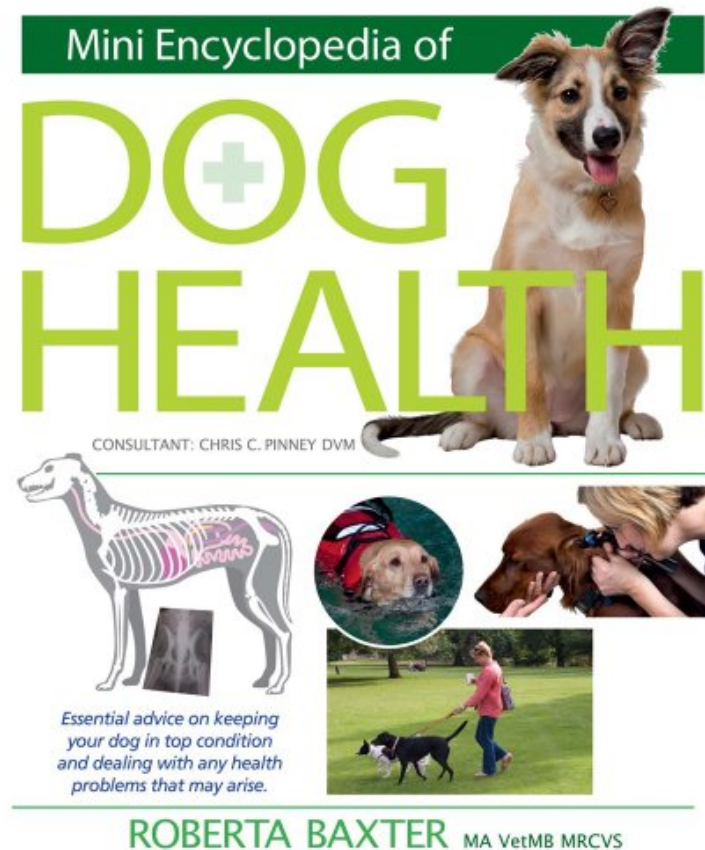

This book explains a lot of health issues that could happen to your dog during its life time so it's good to have this book to prepare. There are a lot of photos that are relevant to the text, and also includes a number of x-rays of several dogs. The book is comprised of three main sections.1. How to have a healthy dog(the weekly check, traveling with your dog, vaccinations, worming, dental care, training exercise, etc.)2. Guide to health problems(every/most types of diseases, such as skin, digestive, liver, kidney, urinary, reproductive, hormonal, etc.)3. First Aid and emergencies(first aid, collapse, lameness, wounds, bites stings, poison, toiling, vomiting, vaginal

discharge, and euthanasia.) Aside from veterinarians who should already know everything in this book, I would recommend this to every doggie owner.

Keeping a dog in good health from its puppy stage to old age is every owner's responsibility.
