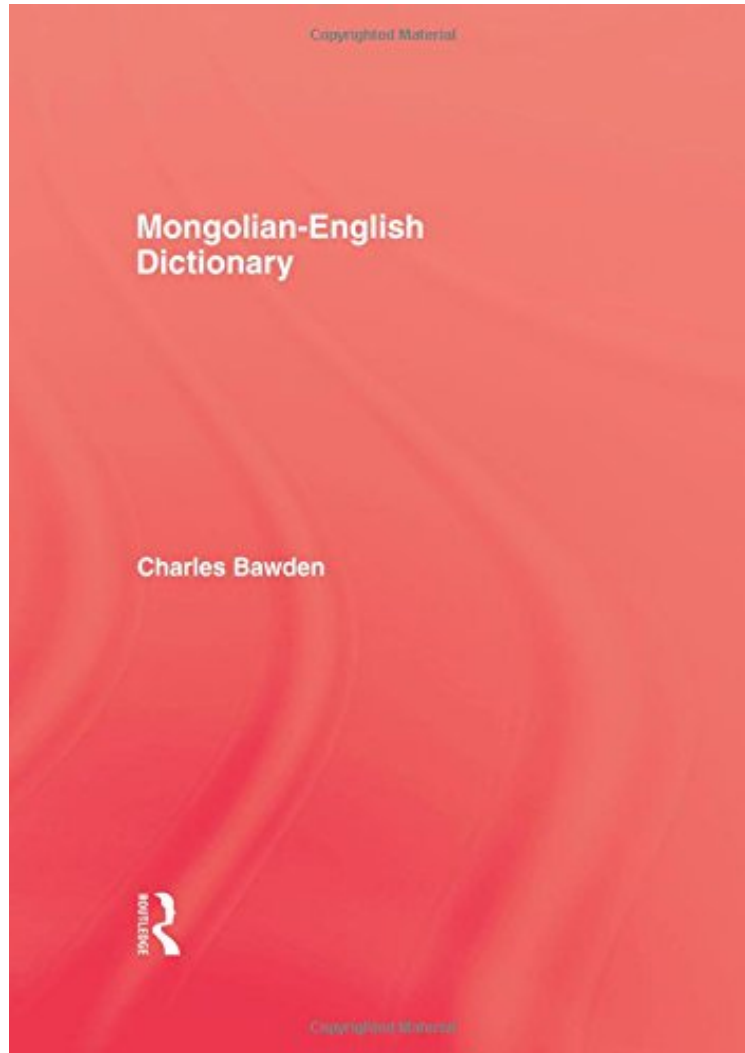

I have the hardback, which is an expensive item, but the paperback and Kindle editions are far more accessible. I can't recommend it highly enough. Professor Charles Bawden taught Mongolian at the School of Oriental and African Studies, London, and sadly died in the summer of 2016. He was the author of several books, including an annotated translation of the anonymous Altan Tobchi [Golden Summary] from the 17th Century. The dictionary was planned in 1963 and first published in 1997. This isn't a book for
