It was between this map and the National Geographic map of Morocco. I went with this map because of the city insets. The NG map is 1:1,000,000 and this map is 1:1,200,000, so the NG map is slightly larger scale. I have a NG map of New Zealand that's nothing special, and extra space on the margins is used for large color pictures of attractions instead of actually useful information-WTF? This International Travel Map is an extremely nice map as maps go. The printing is of very high quality on the standard waterproof synthetic paper. There's a complete index and the legend includes symbols for every imaginable feature from oasis's to mosques. Includes all the roads and details but much easier to read than than a typical Michelin map for instance.
Slightly off topic, but if you are an experienced traveler and are on the fence about going to Morocco, just go! I can't think of a better destination in the world for a citizen of an advanced western nation to go to experience a completely different culture.
