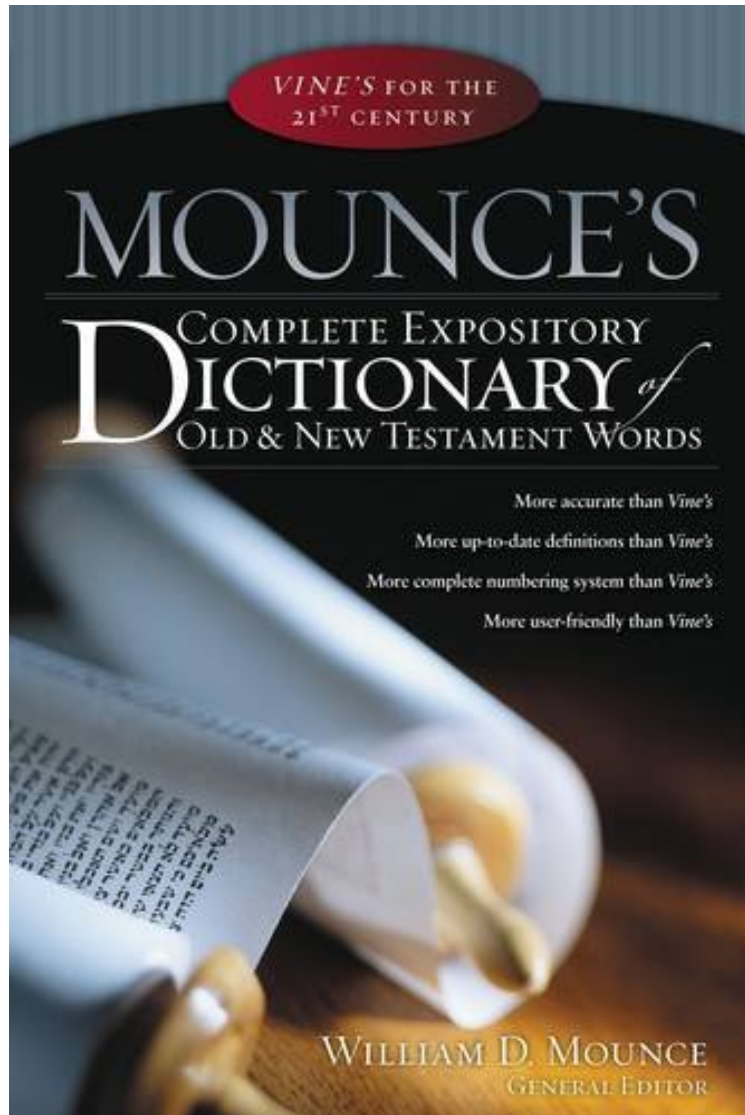

were omitted, words that might not be considered politically expedient to have in such a book. This disappointed me, because it lowers the integrity of this work. There also were some interpretations in the book that are not universally accepted to be fact by Biblical and language scholars. But overall, this is a great tool, one that I'll use alongside my other resources. For someone just getting into the languages or someone who has no understanding of the languages at all, this can be a good tool, although it should not be used as the last word on some translational matters. It's best used alongside other tools, and I wouldn't want for anyone to be constructing personal theologies from a book such as this, as good as the book is. We must still look to our more accurate translations, and use a book such as this one as a tool for understanding.
