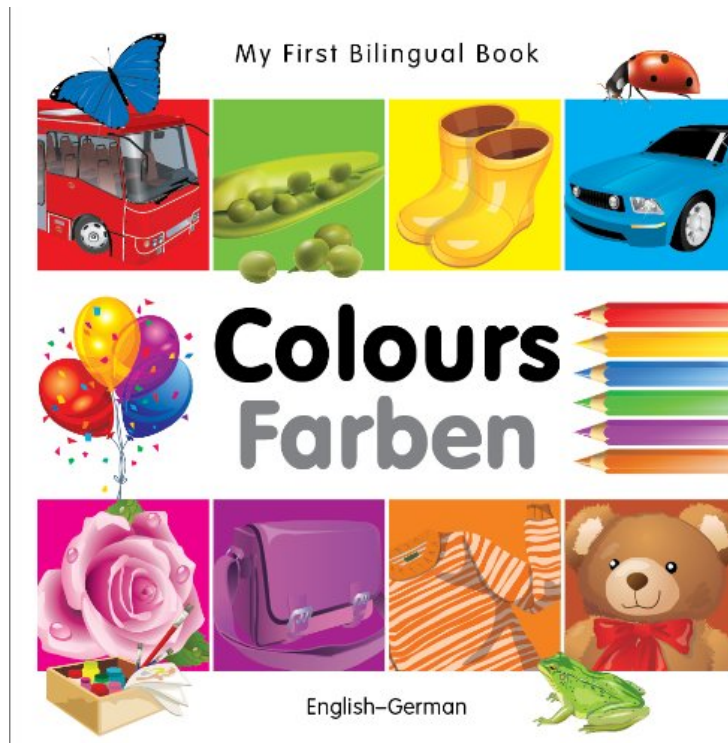

The pages are not as thick as the thickest board-books, but seem plenty durable. The colors and the items are labeled in both languages. I am thoroughly pleased with the visual appeal of this book. It contains brightly colored depictions of numerous objects that are each color, along with a bright swath of just plain color (as from a paint brush) at the bottom. Some of the objects are illustrations, and some are actual photos. For example, the page with green contains a very realistic photo of a Granny Smith apple, an opened pea pod photo, and illustrations of a generic leaf and a generic frog. My rating of this book is in contrast to many other books I've come across in the past. I wasn't quite sure what to expect, when I ordered this, but I'm very pleased. Here's why: It seems like sometimes with German language books for kids, the images are old-fashioned, just plain bad/boring, or worse, developmentally inappropriate for very young children. For example, I have seen "My first [fill in the blank] vocabulary" books, with pictures of things that are RIDICULOUS for a child just learning to talk/read. Either the items (or the words for the items) are much too complex, or they are things that are simply not a part of basic vocab for a toddler.
