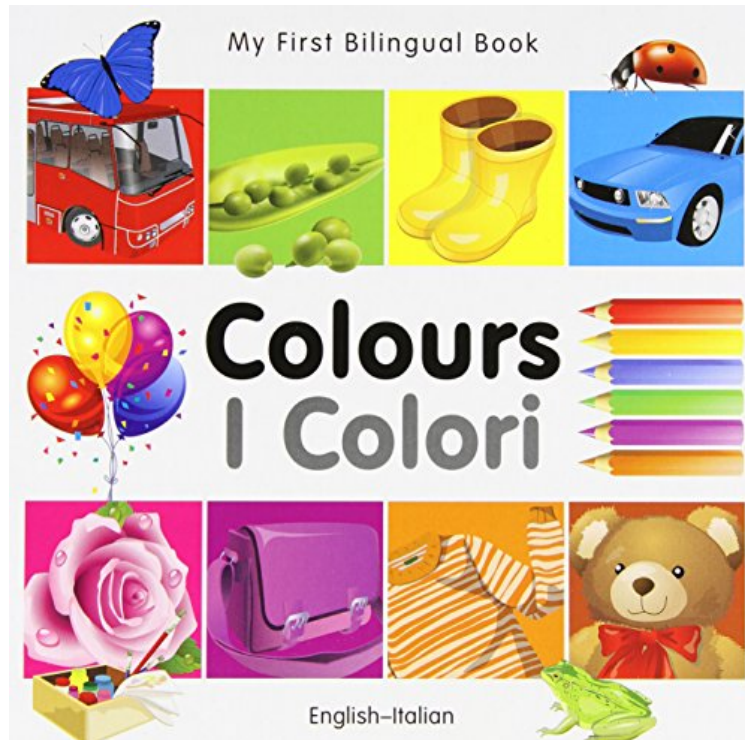

These are great books for households where both parents don't speak Italian, since they provide the word in both Italian and English. The only downside (for the whole series) is that it's not a story book, it's a dictionary/flashcard style book, so it can sometimes be difficult to hold a baby/toddler's attention with this. With the limited Italian bilingual material out there, I would still highly recommend them. The "Colors-I Colori," along with My First Bilingual Book-Numbers (English-Italian), are the best in the series as they also show vocabulary for nouns that are the color being taught on that page. 1 of 1 people found the following review helpful.
